### CA Adds New Lines, NJ Adds PVC Line

As you know, the export market for most resins continues to be strong. And our customers keep asking us to help meet their continuing export and packaging demands with modern and efficient state-of-the-art equipment. To accommodate our current and future customers, we recently added 3 new packaging lines in both our California and New Jersey facilities.

In California we have added a new Open Mouth Sewn line to our packaging arsenal. This new line is installed with a state-of-art palletizing robot similar to the one we installed at our Edison New Jersey facility last summer. The robot and the associated conveyors will enable us to package and palletize 25kg bags more efficiently.



In New Jersey this April we commissioned another Box line and dedicated transfer unit. In addition, we purchased a new transfer unit capable of conveying material in excess of 70,000 lbs per hour and a new FIBC filling line dedicated for PVC. We are installing this in a new building a few thousand feet from our Fieldcrest Avenue location. This new building and equipment will be exclusively for PVC and will enable domestic PVC producers and traders to export PVC, filled into FIBC's, from the New Jersey ports, bypassing the congestion and container shortage in the Gulf.

As always, we continue to develop long-term logistic solutions for our customers that make both them and Plastic Express more efficient and profitable. May we work with you on your next logistic project?



Plastic Express has added another new terminal to better service our customers. Our 12th terminal is located at Guilderland Center, New York, just outside of Albany. Bulk truck deliveries for eastern, central and upper state New York as well as Vermont andMassachusetts can now originate from our new Guilderland Center Terminal. This substantially shortens the distance our trucks travel to deliver resin in these northern areas. Shorter distances = reduced costs = reduced rates. The terminal is serviced by the CSX and Canadian Pacific Railroads as well as interchanges with the NS. Rail service to Guilderland Center and storage costs are competitively priced.
